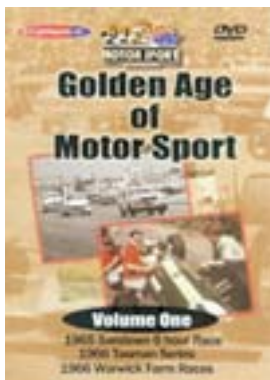

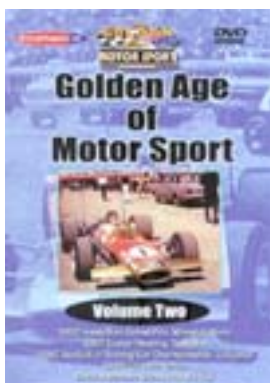

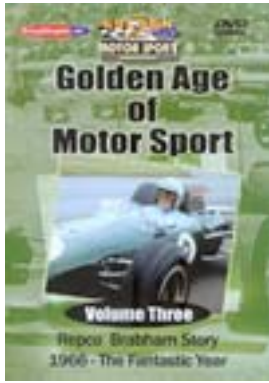
The Easter Bathurst meeting with single seaters, sports and touring cars in action at the famed Mt Panorama circuit, when Kevin Bartlett recorded the first ever 100 mph lap.

The 1967 Australian Touring Car Championship at Lakeside in Queensland when tin top heroes Norm Beechey in the Chevy Nova dueled with Pete Geoghegan's Mustang.

The highlight is the 1969 Tasman Series with rare footage of the high winged Lotus 49T's of Graham Hill and Jochen Rindt, Chris Amon in the Dino Ferrari, Piers Courage, Derek Bell and Jack Brabham in a special Repco Brabham. Cosworth even built 2.5 litre versions of the DFV, called the DFW, just for the series.

A unique race in 1969 was the Japanese Grand Prix held on the banked Mt Fuji circuit with an Australian contingent of Kevin Bartlett and Leo Geoghegan competing to take on the locals at their own game.

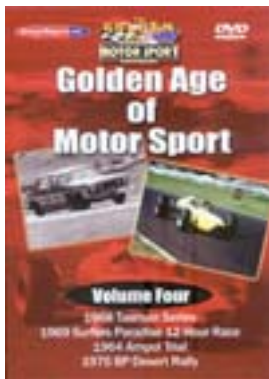

The 1968 Tasman Series saw the international debut of the Gold Leaf liveried Team Lotus 49's. Sadly these races would be the last for Jim Clark. He and Chris Amon in the Dino powered Ferrari put on a stirring battle, against Graham Hill, Jack Brabham, Denny Hulme and Piers Courage. In early 1969 Surfers Paradise staged a 12 hour production race with Ford, Holden, Alfa Romeo and Mini all battling for top honours.

The 1964 Ampol Trial revived the tradition of long distance rallies – however taking part in a Lightburn Zeta, the most unlikely competition vehicle in Australian motor sport history was even more of a challenge.

The BP Desert Rally showed that Baja style off road racing had firmly taken hold in Australia in 1975. In fact many vehicles competing today don't look much different.

In this first of five superb volumes, we join John as he leaves for Le Mans to observe the Jaguar squad in action. Over the next 150 minutes this fascinating double disc DVD volume follows a superb record of racing at Snetterton, Goodwood and Silverstone in England. One year later, John returns to Le Mans for the D Type Jaguar debut, before moving on to the famous French track at Rheims for international sports car racing. Then comes the French Grand Prix, with the debut of Mercedes, back to England to watch Gonzalez and Hawthorn in supreme form at Silverstone. On to Italy to see Fangio winning at Monza, and then Moss winning at Aintree, as the new Vanwell racing car is unveiled.

In 1955 John Tate, fuelled by a growing enthusiasm, visits Silverstone and Goodwood several times to see the heroes of the day locked in combat on the track. He then crosses the English Channel once more, destination Le Mans where he would witness motor racing's greatest public tragedy, as Mercedes withdraws from racing altogether following the mass fatalities during a terrifying racing accident at the height of the 24 hour event.

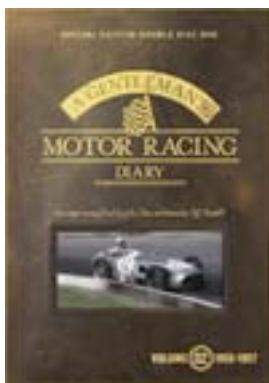

In this second of five superb volumes, John arrives at Aintree for the 1955 British Grand Prix where he sees Stirling Moss win for Mercedes Benz. Late August, and he is at glorious Goodwood for the Nine Hours where Aston Martin score a hatrick, but the year doesn't close before Tate takes his camera to observe two highly contrasting events. The Fifty years of Flying display at Farnborough, and then the London to Brighton Veteran Car Run.

1956 sees Tate at Silverstone to watch Hawthorn almost win for BRM, then to Germany's legendary Nurburgring for the 1000K Endurance, before recording Fangio winning the British Grand Prix, as the beautiful Lancia Ferrari's steal the show. Trips to Monza and then the Monaco grand Prix follow, before arriving in Rouen for the French Grand Prix Fangio's last but one victory, with superb car control. John Tate finally returns to Monza in September 1957 to witness Vanwall make history of the legendary banking of Italy's infamous race track.

The year closes in the English country village of Bletchingly, for the annual Aston Martin Owners Club meet.

This is the third volume in the series of John Tate's remarkable film collection. As a talented film maker, from 1953 until the mid '70s he travelled to the great motor racing events of Europe, where he also recorded the detail of the day in his personal diaries. Attached to the Connaught, Aston Martin and Rob Walker teams, he left to the world a unique insight into motor racing at a time of great change and all filmed in glorious colour throughout the entire series.

In this volume, number three of five in all, we travel with John to Monza in April 1958, where he observes a vintage Bentley record attempt on the legendary banked track. In mid May that year he's in Monaco to see the French hero Trintignant win in the Cooper, and then on to the ultimate driver's circuit at Spa, where Tony Brooks stars for Vanwall.

At Le Mans, the Aston Martin team swallow the bitter pill of defeat, when Ferrari win with Hill and Gendebien as their drivers, and then later that summer Tate's camera is in action again at Silverstone for the St John Horsfall trophy.

1959 would be an action packed year. Aston Martin test their new Formula 1 cars alongside the sports cars at Goodwood, and Tate takes his camera inside Aston's HQ at Feltham, before departing with the team to America for the Sebring 12 hours in Florida. Then comes a win for Stirling Moss driving the new DB4 in the International Trophy at Silverstone, before heading off to catch Jo Bonnier in the BRM winning the Dutch Grand Prix at Zandvoort. After that it's on to Germany for the 1000Ks at the Nurburgring, and then south to Le Mans where he joins the Aston Martin Team to celebrate a magnificent victory in the world famous 24 hour race.

A Gentleman's Motor Racing Diary Volume 4 1959-1963

John Tate was a talented film maker with a passion for motorsport. From 1953 until the mid 1970s, he travelled with his camera to the great motor racing events of Europe, while at the same time recording the events of the day in his personal diary. Attached at different times to the Connaught, Aston Martin and Rob Walker teams, he left to the

world a unique insight into motor racing at a time of great change and development.

In this the fourth of five volumes of a Gentleman's Motor Racing Diary, we begin in July 1959, and join Tate at the British Grand Prix at Aintree where Australian Jack Brabham is in command for Cooper. Then just one month later we see the great Stirling Moss give the Walker team a memorable victory at the Portuguese Grand Prix.

As an avid enthusiast, John Tate must have felt enormous pride as he witnessed Aston Martin secure the World Sports Car Championship at Goodwood that summer. Together with their Le Mans and the Targa Florio victories in the same year, this would be the pinnacle of racing achievement for the mark.

His last visit that year was to Monza for the Italian Grand Prix, where Stirling Moss secures his win with a clever use of tyres.

With the start of a new decade we see John Tate in a flurry of filming enthusiasm. To Monaco where even Ferrari are forced to try the new rear engine layout, while Moss and Walker give Lotus their first Grand Prix victory. Then to Silverstone, where Jack Brabham scores his fourth Grand Prix win in a row, and then on to Goodwood to see the Walker team try GT racing and beat Aston Martin.

1961 will see him at Silverstone, Goodwood and then French Grand Prix at Rheims, where new boy Baghetti scores a scorcher for Ferrari. At Monza Phil Hill takes the Italian Grand Prix in an event marred by tragedy,

By the end of 1963, John Tate will have travelled to another eight great races, including Spa in Belgium to see V8 power begin to give the British teams a chance of beating the Italians. With Stirling Moss badly injured, Jo Bonnier tests for Rob Walker, while at Imola Clark is untouchable and at the Monaco Grand Prix, Graham Hill will score the first of five memorable victories.

All this through the eyes of a man who followed motor racing with a passion, while recording people's thoughts and actions of the day to create a unique film archive. One for you to savour now, and for years to come.

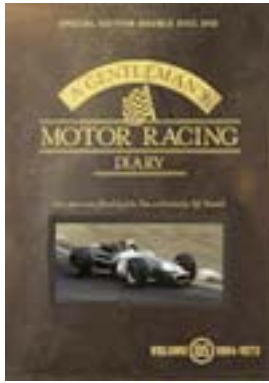

A Gentleman's Motor Racing Diary Volume 5 1964 – 1973

John Tate spent three decades following the evolution of international motorsport, recording his observations on film and in a unique series of diaries. As European countries staggered into recovery in the post World War 2 era, former Spitfire pilot Tate would spend his weekends at race tracks watching and filming his heroes during this most fascinating period of motor racing history. In this fifth and final volume of A Gentleman's Motor Racing Diary, John Tate travels to Lord March's home Goodwood to see his beloved race circuit closed down. Then on to Le Mans for the French Grand Prix where, in 1967, Jack Brabham wins, with Jo Siffert in fourth, despite Colin Chapman fielding the Lotus 49.

The 1967 Italian Grand Prix follows, where John Surtees takes a surprise win for Honda. Then, in 1968, a trip to Silverstone for the Martini Trophy, and a great battle between Frank Gardner's Ford F3L and Denny Hulme's Lola. In 1969 John Tate returns to Silverstone where Jackie Stewart wins. As the 1970s start Jochen Rindt is killed at the Italian GP, while Regazzoni takes his first victory. Then Porsche is unbeatable with the 917 in the 1000K sports car race in Italy in 1971, but it is the extraordinary scenes at the British Grand Prix in 1973 which convince John Tate that it is time to put down his camera and pen for good.

In this last episode of a unique and remarkable record in motorsport's history, John Tate's personal diary is once again spoken by his son Christopher and presented by racing expert Tiff Needell - himself a boyhood enthusiast at the time Tate was creating his very own Gallery of Motorsport.

The Dambuster Raids – The True Story

The story of The Dambusters has passed through history and into legend, inspiring one of the greatest of all World War Two movies.

On May 16th 1943, nineteen Lancaster bombers took off from England's Scampton airfield. They carried one hundred and thirty three men and a unique top secret bomb load, code-named 'Upkeep'. These were men and machinery of The Royal Air Force 617 Squadron and few knew of their existence. Only a handful of others, including Winston Churchill, knew their purpose.

For almost seven years, Britain's military planners had been working on a strategy that would cause huge destruction to the might of the Nazi war machine. A major collapse of Adolf Hitler's industrial complexes in Germany's Ruhr Valley area, might give the Allies a much needed opportunity to turn the tide of the war in Europe.

The idea was to breach the massive dams that supplied so much of the power and water to the vast factories that were producing Germany's military machinery and munitions. Massive flooding could cause the Third Reich's assault on Europe untold damage and delay, but how to achieve it?

The 'bouncing bomb' was the inspiration of Professor Barnes Wallis, but it had to be dropped at low level with crucial backspin, allowing it's huge seven and half ton high explosive payload to be delivered with pin point accuracy.

Specialist bomber crews had been selected for 617 Squadron, and for the lesser known Mosquito Squadron 618, whose targets would be capital ships of the German navy. Men were drawn from other allied nations including Australia and Canada, to join those of the RAF who, in one night's flying, would become heroes. The mission was almost cancelled at the last moment, Winston Churchill giving the final 'go ahead' by secret cypher from America, with just forty eight hours to go. This DVD filmed in colour and B&W tells the truly remarkable story of those 'Dambusters', and their controversial raids on the Moehne, Eder and Sorpe Dams. The film includes testament from German eyewitnesses, a Dutch forced labour survivor, specialists, military historians, and members of the Barnes Wallis family. Unique, previously undiscovered German film of the destruction is seen for the first time.

Gripping memories of some of the crewmen who flew the mission, vividly bring to life the triumph and tragedy of that moonlight night in 1943, when only eighty men and eight aircraft returned from the raid.
